Ordinance No. 2016-8

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A PORTION OF CHAPTER 3  
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FAIRBURY OF 1982  
IN RELATION TO EMPLOYEE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS**

Whereas, the City of Fairbury adopted its Municipal Code Book in 1982, and

Whereas, the Municipal Code Book contains ordinances which govern the operation of the City of Fairbury, and

Whereas, Chapter 3, Section .09 (k) of the Municipal Code Book, relates to employee residency, and

Whereas, it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Fairbury to amend residency requirements for clerical personnel.

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Fairbury, Livingston County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION I

Chapter 3, Section .09 (k) of the Municipal Code of the City of Fairbury of 1982 shall be amended to read;

Employee residency requirement: Every current and future full time employee of the City of Fairbury, except **clerical and** full time sworn Police Officers, shall establish his or her residency within the city limits of the City of Fairbury within one year of the date of being hired and shall maintain said residency within the city limits of the City throughout the period of his or her employment by the City. Full time sworn current and future Police Officers **and clerical** employees shall establish residency within the boundaries established by the Prairie Central Unified School District #8 within one year of the date of being hired and shall maintain said residency within the School District boundaries throughout the period of his or her employment by the City. If a full time employee has not established residency within the city limits of the city within one year of the date of being hired, or as a full time Police Officer **or clerical employee** within the Prairie Central Unified School District #8, he or she may request an extension of said time limit from the corporate authorities for up to six months for good cause shown. Failure to abide by the terms of this subsection shall be cause for termination of employment. For good cause shown, the corporate authorities may grant an employee temporary permission to reside outside the city limits or School District boundaries for a period up to six months.

SECTION II

This ordinance shall be effective after passage by the City Council of the City of Fairbury, Illinois, and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Fairbury, Illinois, and its publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
