Level One:

A level one emergency is what the City of Fairbury considers the everyday emergency within the corporate limits of Fairbury. This situation would require standard responses and assistance from mutual aid agencies with which previous agreements have been agreed upon and are listed by the city and city departments. This may involve the calling out of city employees for normal job performance, i.e. water main break, placement of barricades, road closures, assistance in hazmat cleanup etc. These situations are within the scope of what the City of Fairbury can handle with limited outside involvement; and does not require the calling out of the designated Crisis Management Team.

Level Two:

A level two emergency is what the City of Fairbury's Crisis Management Team would determine is an event requiring the full activation of the Emergency Operations Center. This event would require significant outside assistance from agencies such as (I.E: MABAS/ILEAS). All members of the city Crisis Management Team would report to the City Hall or the secondary backup location.

Level Three:

A level three emergency is what the City of Fairbury calls a event requiring the full activation of the Crisis Management Team and having their presence at the Emergency Operations Center. This event would require a large amount of assistance from outside agencies such as (I.E. MABAS/ILEAS) and or other appropriate resources for the particular event.
