#### Article VII, R-1 SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT, 7.4, C, (2):

Any other accessory building and any structure which is not a building, (other than a fence) may be placed no less than five feet from the rear lot line and 15 feet from the street or alley lot line. Accessory buildings shall be permitted only in side and rear yards.

# Article VIII, R-2 RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT, 8.4, C, (2):

Any other accessory building and any structure which is not a building, (other than a fence) may be placed no less than five feet from the rear lot line and 15 feet from the street or alley lot line. Accessory buildings shall be permitted only in side and rear yards.

### Article IX, R-2-A RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT, 9.4, C, (2):

Any other accessory building and any structure which is not a building, (other than a fence) may be placed no less than five feet from the rear lot line and 15 feet from the street or alley lot line. Accessory buildings shall be permitted only in side and rear yards.

## Article XVII, BUILDING AND OCCUPANCY PERMITS, 17.1, A, (9):

A building permit shall be valid for 12 or 18 months from date of issue. A permit may be extended, upon request, for 1 year. The extension fee shall be twice the amount of the previous permit charge.

### Article XVII, BUILDING AND OCCUPANCY PERMITS, 17.1, B:

The City of Fairbury will issue an Occupancy Permit only upon request.

# **Article XIII, OFF-STREET PARKING REQUIREMENTS**

**O.** Any new establishments not addressed in the above section must obtain parking requirements from the City of Fairbury. (2014-4)
