**Leroy McPherson** was welcomed as the newest member of Planning Commission

The council has approved the bid package for materials for the  $7^{th}$  street water main. The water main will go from  $1^{st}$  street to  $7^{th}$  street on the north side of the trail. It will be a 12'' main that will tie into the current 8'' main from  $4^{th}$  street to Columbia and then to  $7^{th}$  street. A sewer already exists, therefore, the addition of the water main will allow for future development and expansion.

**Someone Else's Treasure** on Locust Street is going out of business.

**Fairview Haven's Serenity Villa** is currently being constructed. It will feature 18 units with a spa and a putting green.

**Charlie Hoselton** has started construction on his new, larger, screen printing business. Miller Trim Works will also be located in the building.

**The Crop Production water main** is finished. Construction can now begin on their buildings.

The Planning Commission made a motion to give Leroy McPherson the authority to work with Ty Eshelman from Farnsworth to update the city maps.
