

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Fairbury is seeking a low interest loan from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's (IEPA) Water Pollution Control Revolving Loan Program to fund the Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Long Term Control Plan (LTCP) Project. The total project cost and requested loan amount is estimated to be approximately \$24,900,000. The City is seeking the loan to perform modifications and improvements to the Waste Water Treatment Plant, collection system, and pump stations. A user rate increase has been passed and will continue to increase to generate repayment funds for this project.

The public is invited to comment on the proposed planning documents and "Project Summary and Preliminary Environmental Impacts Determination". A Public Hearing will be held on May 2, 2018 at 6:15 p.m. at City Hall located at 201 West Locust Street. The documents will also be available for review and comment at the City Hall. A 10-day comment period will follow the Public Hearing and is provided to fulfill the requirements of the IEPA loan program, Section 365.330 of the Illinois Procedure for Issuing Loans from the Public Water Supply Revolving Loan Fund.
