Ordinance No. 2017- 4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 SECTION .04(a)
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FAIRBURY OF 1982
IN RELATION TO GARBAGE COLLECTION SERVICE CHARGES

Whereas, the costs of providing garbage service to the citizens of Fairbury has increased and the garbage collection service charge of the City of Fairbury have not changed since 2008, and

Whereas, it is necessary for the City to maintain garbage collection service charges sufficient to pay the cost of providing such services,

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Fairbury, Livingston County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION I

1. Chapter 6, Section .04(a) of the Municipal Code of the City of Fairbury of 1982 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) There is hereby established a regular garbage collection service charge for garbage picked up within the City of Fairbury as follows:

- (i) Said charge for a single family dwelling will be \$10.00 per month to be billed to the resident.
- (ii) Said charge for a multiple family dwelling shall be \$10.00 per month for each dwelling unit in the multiple family dwelling. In the case of a multiple family dwelling unit having individual water meters for each dwelling unit, the charge for each dwelling unit shall be billed to the person in whose name the water meter is listed. In the case of multiple family dwelling units without individual water meters for each unit, then said charge for each dwelling unit shall be billed to the person in whose name the water meter is listed. (1998-17)
- (iii) Said charges for units in senior citizen assisted living facilities shall be \$7.00 per month for each unit.
- (iv) Said charges for all non-residential users shall be as follows:
 - (A) Non-residential users producing up to .2 cubic yards of garbage per week shall be charged \$11.00 per billing period.
 - (B) Non-residential users who do not have a dumpster and produce from .2 to 1.0 cubic yards of garbage per week shall be charged \$14.00 per billing period.
 - (C) Non-residential users who do not have a dumpster and produce more than 1.0 cubic yard of garbage per week shall be charged \$4.00 per cubic yard for each time the garbage is picked up, with a minimum charge of \$14.00 per billing period.
 - (D) Non-residential users with a dumpster shall be charged \$4.00 per cubic yard based upon the capacity of the dumpster. Said charge shall be charged each time the

- dumpster is picked up with a minimum \$14.00 charge per billing period.
- (E) For non-residential users, the term "billing period" shall mean the monthly period covered by the water and sewerage billing cycle.
 - (F) The non-residential charges set forth above are based upon one garbage pick-up per week. Any non-residential user having more than one garbage pick-up per week shall be charged \$4.00 per cubic yard for each time that his garbage is picked up, with a minimum charge of \$14.00 per billing period. All non-residential users shall be charged individually whether they have their garbage set out separately or whether it is co-mingled with the garbage of other non-residential users in a common dumpster or otherwise. Where several non-residential users are located in the same building, each non-residential user shall be billed separately at the current rate for non-residential users.
- (v) The regular garbage collection service charges set forth above shall be charged for each month or part of a month that such services are provided, without pro-ration.

SECTION II

The rates and service charges established in this ordinance shall be effective as of the usage period beginning May 20, 2017, on bills to be rendered on June 15, 2017.

SECTION III


All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be effective after passage by the City Council of the City of Fairbury, Illinois, and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Fairbury, Illinois, and its publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
