The Planning Commission held a meeting at 12 Noon. Members present were Chairman Rick Wilson, Leroy McPherson, Tracy Taylor and Michael Blackwell, Ron Schlipf, Bekah Fehr and Jeremy Leman. Also in attendance were City Superintendent Brett Ashburn and Planning Commission secretary Stephanie Meints.

On January 1, 2020 the legalization of marijuana will take place in Illinois. The Planning commission discussed the pros and cons of allowing dispensaries in the City of Fairbury.
