CONSOLIDATED ELECTION

April 6, 2021

September 22, 2020 - First day to circulate petitions for Municipal Independent candidates in the City of Fairbury.

1 Mayor to be elected
1 Alderman in each ward to be elected.

December 14, 2020 - First day for filing nominating petitions for independent candidates in municipalities.

December 21, 2020 - Last day to file nominating petitions.

Nominating Petition packets include:

- ★ Petition Sheets
- ★ Statement of Candidacy
- ★ Loyalty Oath
- ★ **Receipt** for Statement of Economic Interest – Only the receipt is filed with the City Clerk in Fairbury. The entire statement must be filed with the County Clerk at the Court House in Pontiac and be stamped in year 2020.

SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS

Petitions - Independent - Not less than 5% or more than 8% (max 50 more than minimum of greater than 8%. Based on number of persons voting in last regular election.
