**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES
 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING APRIL 30, 2022**

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Fairbury, Livingston County, Illinois did on July 21, 2021 pass the final appropriation bill for said City for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2022, the amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of \$9,214,725 which said appropriation bill was duly published on July 22, 2021,

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Fairbury, Livingston County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION I

That there be and is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Fairbury, Livingston County, Illinois, subject to taxes for the year 2021, payable in 2022, the total sum of \$935,000 for the following specific purposes mentioned in said appropriation bill and in the respective sums as follows:


