AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7, SECTION .19 OF THE
MUNICIPAL CODE BOOK OF THE CITY OF FAIRBURY OF 1982
IN RELATION TO HALLOWEEN TRICK OR TREAT HOURS

Whereas, Halloween Trick or Treat is a custom observed by many Fairbury residents, and

Whereas, it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Fairbury to keep our children safe while trick or treating, and

Whereas, the established hours for trick or treating are not conducive to young children.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Fairbury, Livingston County, Illinois that Chapter 7, Section .19 of the City of Fairbury Municipal Code of 1982 shall be stricken and replaced with the following:

SECTION I

.19 HALLOWEEN TRICK OR TREAT HOURS. Trick or treat hours for Halloween shall be from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on October 31st of every year. "Trick or Treat", for purposes of this section refers to children going to residential areas and residences to ask for Halloween treats and does not apply to business, religious, or local government sponsored Halloween activities that do not involve private residences.

SECTION II

All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be effective immediately after passage by the City Council of the City of Fairbury, Illinois, and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Fairbury, Illinois, and its publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
