WASTE

One 95-gallon waste container is provided to each residence. These sturdy collection containers are easily rolled, have an attached lid and will allow for more efficient waste collection. These containers are the property of GFL and are assigned to your household address.

Please bag all waste placed in carts. Do not place electronic waste, hazardous waste, or yard waste in your trash. Old paint cans will only be collected if they are dry and have their lids removed.

- For households north of the railroad tracks, waste will be picked up weekly, starting Tuesday August 2, 2022.
- For households south of the railroad tracks, waste will be picked up weekly, starting Monday August 1, 2022.

The fee for basic trash service, including the 95-gallon trash cart, is invoiced on the monthly utility bill from the City of Fairbury. If you need additional waste containers, please contact the City of Fairbury at 815,692,2743.



RECYCLING

Curbside recycling is offered to Fairbury residents. One 95-gallon recycling container is provided to Fairbury households. Recycling will be picked up every other week on Tuesdays. Please see referenced calendar on the City's website for exact pick up days.

The fee for basic recycling service, including the 95-gallon recycling cart, is invoiced on the monthly utility bill from the City of Fairbury. If you need additional containers, please contact the City of Fairbury at **815.692.2743.**

The City of Fairbury's recycling will be processed by GFL at its recycling center in Pekin, IL. Please do not bag recycling material.



What can be recycled?

Acceptable items for recycling include:

- Plastics (#1 and #2)
- Cardboard from cereal, gift and packing boxes
- Paper including newspapers, catalogs, phone books, magazines and junk mail
- Steel, aluminum and bi-metal cans

The following items must **NOT** be placed in recycling:

Glass

CART PLACEMENT AND GUIDELINES

- Place carts at the curb the night before or by 6am the morning of pick up.
- Place carts in the street against the curb at least 5 feet away from mailboxes, cars and other obstructions.
- Position carts with the handle and wheels facing the house and curb.
- If trash and recycling carts are set out on the same day, separate them by five feet.
- Established alley pickup will continue.
- Please do not overstuff carts; lids should be kept closed to keep out precipitation.

Please note that GFL will not collect trash or recycling on the following holidays. Service will resume on the next scheduled pick-up day.

- Memorial Day
- 4th of July
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day
